



"HTML BOOKMARK"

BOOKMARK

- **id:** An attribute used to assign a unique identifier to an element on the page.
- **href:** Stands for Hypertext Reference, to specify the link's destination.

How to Create a Bookmark in HTML

- **Set the Target:** Add an **id** to the element where you want to jump (bookmark).
- **Create the Link:** Use the **<a>** tag with **href="#idName"** to link to the bookmark.

<!-- Bookmark Target for Section 1 -->
<h2 id="section1">Section 1</h2>
<p>This is the content for Section 1.</p>

<!-- More content to scroll past -->
<p>Content between sections...</p>

<!-- Bookmark Target for Section 2 -->
<h2 id="section2">Section 2</h2>
<p>This is the content for Section 2.</p>

<!-- More content to scroll past -->
<p>Additional content between sections...</p>

<!-- Bookmark Target for Section 3 -->
<h2 id="section3">Section 3</h2>
<p>This is the content for Section 3.</p>

<!-- Back to top link -->
<p><a href="#top">Back to Top</a></p>
