

BOOKMARK

- id: An attribute used to assign a unique identifier to an element on the page.
- href: Stands for Hypertext Reference, to specify the link's destination.

How to Create a Bookmark in HTML

- Set the Target: Add an id to the element where you want to jump (bookmark).
- Create the Link: Use the <a> tag with

href="#idName" to link to the bookmark.
